Increasing value of biomedical research: the Lancet-REWARD campaign

Italian REWARD Conference, hosted by GIMBE Foundation

Recently, several initiatives have witnessed a renewed interest for biomedical research in Italy: a new call for the independent drugs research program by Italian Medicines Agency, funds for Human Technopole ja predictive medicine antonia centro; a clife of a National Agency for Research. This has de to the need for indicious to measure the return of funds invested in biomedical research: scientific productivity, quality of published evidence, impact of research on the National Health Sirveire and on health outcomes, beside patents and acrofiles.
